networking@ippn.ie - IPPN's networking mailing list is one of the most valued services as it can offer you peer-to-peer support based on the experience of school leaders from the very smallest of our one teacher schools to the very largest. There is a huge variety of school types and sizes with the stated aim of providing collegial support to the subscribers. Some members are frequent contributors, while others learn from the discussion threads on a variety of topics without actually submitting a posting. Members ask questions, seek advice and share good practice.

newprincipals@ippn.ie - This mailing list is specifically for new principals in their first year in the role. This can be a daunting time for a new school leader where one might think that the question posed may be considered silly. There is no such thing as a silly question, but it is easier to put those questions to colleagues who are in the same position as oneself. This mailing list is facilitated by members of the Leadership Support Team and invites collegial support and sharing of good practice.
