# INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A DOCTORAL RESEARCH STUDY:

## What is the study about?

This study examines language acquisition by migrant children in primary education. The particular focus of the study is on the acquisition of **academic language** and **literacy skills**, in both language support and mainstream settings, as key determinants of the future educational achievement and social integration of migrant children, both in Ireland, where migrant education is still a relatively young topic, and in Germany, where discourse in the field is significantly more advanced due to an older history of in-migration.

# Who is carrying out the study?
