This year the form will be posted on www.education.ie rather than on OLCS. The Census form for Special Schools will continue to be posted on OLCS. When complete the form is emailed to primarycensus@education.gov.ie by 31st October. If any difficulties arise a contact number is provided – 01 8892085. It is useful to collect the required information with the assistance of the DP, secretary and SEN team. Once inputted there are useful checks on the system to ensure that the numbers balance. Usually in my own experience, I would always be missing one or two who take ages to track down. Don't worry about this as it happens to most principals at this time of the year! Now might also be a good time to put in place a system for recording new entrants from 1/10/2014 and those who leave the school during the school year. It will make tracking easier for next year.
