 The FSSU Calendar may be a helpful reference for the Treasurer of the BoM when dealing with school finances. The dates for Revenue returns are the latest date a return should be filed and paid on ROS i.e. returns can be filed before the 23rd of the month. Filing frequency varies from school to school i.e. some schools are set up for monthly RCT returns and PAYE/PRSI/USC/LPT payments, while others file quarterly.
