PLANNING

- Plan for school tours and seek BOM approval. Ensure that the bus company used to transport pupils on tours is compliant with all appropriate regulations and request copies of insurance from providers. Make sure that all staff members are familiar with Critical Incidents Plan - in case of emergency while on tour.
- Finalise plans for Sacramental Preparation, where appropriate
- Set dates for the administration of Standardised Tests in May. Decide what format this will take and ensure that adequate test papers and manuals are ordered. Who will coordinate the testing process? How will results be gathered and recorded?
- Initiate or continue discussion regarding staff rotation and allocation for the next school year after the mid-term break. Prepare a class preference sheet and decide when to distribute it. Seek advice if necessary regarding the best manner and use of language to approach these discussions. Refer to any school policies in this regard.

BoM

- Continue to process leave applications. Communication of decisions should be seen to come from the BoM.
- Refer to Circulars 2/2024 and 11/2024 with regard to the deadline of 29 February for submission of staffing documents.
